

**MENTAL STATUS EXAMINATION:**

*John is a 10-year-old, Caucasian American male, who appears his stated chronological age when assessed. He presents average weight and average height. He denies any tattoos or scarring on his body. He presents appropriately dressed and well-groomed wearing a Blue sweater and earphones. His attitude is cooperative. He presents easily engaged and maintains fair eye contact. His motor activity is unremarkable. There are no abnormal involuntary movements during the assessment. He is not responding to internal stimuli. His speech is remarkable, with slow pace, normal volume, and articulation. His mood is unremarkable stating He is feeling "fine." His affect is full, with normal intensity and labile modulation. He is appropriate to content. His thought process is unremarkable, with no display of tangential, circumstantial, vague, blocking, looseness of association, clang associations, incoherent, racing, flight of ideas, perseveration, compulsive thinking, or magical thinking. He presents with logical thinking. His thought content is unremarkable, with the absence of preoccupations, rumination, obsessions, poverty of ideas, phobias, or ideas of reference. He denies delusions. There are no minimal, moderate, or pervasive delusions. His perception is unremarkable. He denies current auditory, visual, olfactory, tactile, and gustatory hallucinations. His cognition requires a formal assessment but appears grossly intact. He is fully oriented to time, place, person, and circumstance. He does not present with any hostile intent during the assessment. His knowledge and intelligence appear to be average. His concentration and attention appear to be intact. His memory appears intact and fair with the ability for immediate, recent, and remote recall as fair. His abstract thinking is intact. For age and level of education, his fund of knowledge and judgement are fair, and his insight is moderate*
